3. Please read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-4. How does Paul know that God has chosen the Thessalonians? What evidence does he see that God is at work in them? How do you define the work of faith? The labor of love? The steadfastness of hope? How have you seen these in your own experience?

4. Please read 1 Thessalonians 1:5. What do you notice about the way the gospel came to Thessalonica? What did God do? What did Paul and his companions do? What do you learn about effective evangelism from this verse?

5. Please read 1 Thessalonians 1:6-10. What effects do you observe of the gospel coming to Thessalonica? Why is reproduction so important to the spread of the gospel? If the gospel stops with us and doesn't spread beyond us, what does this imply about our faith in the gospel?

6. What do you learn from this chapter about a healthy Christian? About a healthy church?
