- 6. Please read Malachi 3:16-17. How do the people of faith in Israel respond to God's charge? What do you think they said to one another? What is the book of remembrance of those who put their faith in God now? (Revelation 20:15)
- 7. Why do you think that God does not make the clear distinction between the righteous and the wicked today which He will make in the future?
- 8. In what area of your life do you need to gain a clearer understanding of the rewards of following Christ? What will you do?
