- 4. Malachi prophesies about the Day of the Lord (4:1f; see 3:18). How is this prophecy partially fulfilled at Christ's First Coming (see Matthew 3:12; 11:14; Luke 1:16-17, 76-79). Why will this prophecy only be completely fulfilled at Christ's Second Coming (see Revelation 11:3; Matthew 25:31-46)?
- 5. Who is the prophecy of Malachi 4:1-6 directed towards (see v. 6; see also Matthew 3:8-9)? How does this serve as a wake-up call for God's visible people?

Application

- 6. How does God tell Israel to turn back (see 3:7) to him (4:4, 6)? What stands out to you about the marks of the repentant? What implications do you see for your own life?
- 7. What's one thing you can do this week to apply this passage?
